- 1. BRAINFUSE** has live, online tutors available every day from 2 to 11 p.m.
- 2. CQ RESEARCHER** features in-depth, authoritative reports on political and social-policy issues extending back a decade (middle school grades and up).
- 3. CULTURE GRAMS** offers cultural information about countries, states, and Canadian provinces.
- 4. HOOPLA** has simultaneous-use eBooks, audiobooks, movies & music (limit 20 checkouts per month). A whole class can have the same item checked out at the same time.
- 5. KANOPY** features critically acclaimed movies, inspiring documentaries, award-winning foreign films and more (limit 10 checkouts per month).
- 6. MANGO & MUZZY** are for language learning. Mango has over 70 languages available. Muzzy has been developed for children and features 7 languages.
- 7. NOVELIST** recommends read-alikes when you type in favorite authors, titles, or series.
- 8. OVERDRIVE** offers single-use eBooks and audiobooks except for the simultaneous use collection "Books for the Whole Classroom" under our OverDrive "Kids" & "Teens" links.
- 9. TUMBLEBOOKS** are animated picture books and read-alongs, which can be accessed from home.
- 10. WORLD BOOK ONLINE** includes current headline news, videos, a biography center, virtual tours, and a citation builder along with the World Book Encyclopedia, elementary to high school levels.
